Entry Requirements

Pass SPM / SPMV / O-Levels credit in at least three (3) subjects; Pass SPM / SPMV / O-Level with credit in at least 3 subjects;

Pass Sijil Kemahiran Malaysia (SKM) (Level 3 MQF) in relevant field subject to Senate approval and MUST attend bridging courses;

A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM), with a minimum of Grade C (GP 2.0) in any subject; OR

Any qualifications equivalent to Certificate (Level 3, MQF); OR

A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Maqbul;

Any other qualifications that recognised by the Malaysian government;

Entry requirements for admission into the Diploma's program (level 5, MQF) through APEL A as approved by the Ministry of Education (MOHE). Applicants must be/have:

- 1. A Malaysian citizen; and
- 2. The candidate should be more than 20 years of age in the year of application
- 3. Relevant work experience / prior experiential learning; and
