## Entry Requirements

A pass in SPM / SPMV / O-Level with a minimum of three (3) credits in any subject;

OR

A pass in Sijil Kemahiran Malaysia (SKM) (Level 3 MQF) in a relevant field subject to Senate approval and MUST attend bridging courses;

OR

A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM), with a minimum of Grade C (GP 2.0) in any subject;

OR

Any qualifications equivalent to Certificate (Level 3, MQF);

OR

A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Maqbul;

OR

Any other equivalent qualifications recognised by the Malaysian Government;

OR

Entry requirements for admission into the Diploma's program (level 5, MQF) through APEL A as approved by the Ministry of Education (MOHE). Applicants must be/have:

1. A Malaysian citizen; AND
2. The candidate should be more than 20 years of age in the year of application
3. Relevant work experience / prior experiential learning; AND
4. Pass the APEL Assessment
